The threat to the State, community and school students is imminent as reported by federal and state officials and the situation qualifies as an epidemic under Govt. Code § 551.045(b)(2)(C).

If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in an executive or closed session, the Board will convene in such executive or closed session as permitted by and in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551.
