Google Classroom and Zoom Safety

We share parents' rightful concerns for online student safety as we navigate remote learning. In particular, there have been a few recent news articles about the safety of the Zoom platform.

We want to assure you that, with the proper settings, Great Hearts is confident in the safety of both Google Classroom and Zoom. Unauthorized users "popping into" our Zoom accounts can be prevented by turning on features such as the "Waiting Room" and required passwords, two of the many steps Great Hearts is taking to protect our students.

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2nd Semester Grading Policy

Prep Schools:

Students' Quarter 4 remote learning coursework will be graded on a simple "Pass/Fail" basis; Semester 2 courses will be letter graded.

Students who earn a "Pass" in Q4 will receive a letter grade for Semester 2 that is no lower than the letter grade earned for the same course in Quarter 3; distinguished coursework in Q4 may result in a Semester 2 letter grade that is higher than the Q3 grade.

Any courses taken only in Quarter 4 will be graded according to an A-F letter grade scale.

In the event that a student earns a "Fail" for Q4 coursework, the letter grade for that course may be lower than the Quarter 3 grade, including the possibility of an "F" for the semester and no credits earned.

Archway Schools:

Students' Quarter 4 coursework will be graded on a simple "Pass/Fail" basis. As a reminder, Archway students do not receive semester grades.

The headmaster has the authority to retain a student on the basis of cumulative grades and/or lack of academic proficiency and readiness for the next grade level.
