HR will also be notified if subject is an employee Executive Director will assemble the GH COVID Response Team Close off and disinfect all non-porous surfaces asap Determine where the student or employee has been and whom they have had close contact with for the past 72 hours. Close contact is defined as within 6 ft for more than 15 minutes or directly exposed to infectious secretions (e.g., being coughed on). Communicate directly to all adults/students who have come into "close contact" with the subject and quarantine for 14 days. Communicate in a manner consistent with other infectious disease notifications and legal confidentiality requirements to: All Faculty members if subject is a faculty member Families in the same section as the student/teacher All teachers of the student if the subject is a student Ask the parent if they would like the student to engage in GHDL (may return before quarter) If Teacher/staff – determine coverage School Closure, section or grade level quarantines will be determined by the GH Response Team with advisement from their Local County Department of Health |

Close Contact with Someone Who Tested Positive for Covid-19

Close contact is defined as being *within 6 ft for 15* minutes or more however, additional factors like case/contact masking (i.e. both infectious individual and potential close contact have been consistently and properly masked), presence of dividers, and case symptomology may affect determination) or *being directly exposed to infectious secretions* (e.g., being coughed on)
