

Close Contact Quarantine Policy

Updated 9.9.21

- 1. Campuses will conduct contact tracing to identify close contacts of individuals who test positive for COVID-19 and were on campus during their infectious period. *
- 2. Identified close contacts will be notified by email. A separate email to parents of anyone in the affected section will be sent.
- 3. Campus close contacts are not required to quarantine if asymptomatic. Parents should monitor their child for symptoms for 14 days after exposure. We strongly recommend close contacts wear a mask while on campus.
- 4. If symptoms develop within 14 days of exposure the close contact must quarantine.
- 5. Unvaccinated household close contacts (anyone living under the same roof as the infected individual) are required to quarantine for 10 days from infected person's onset of symptoms. We highly recommend that household close contacts test for COVID-19 prior to returning to campus. They can schedule testing with the campus nurse.
- 6. Household contacts with prior COVID-19 infection within the past three months are exempt from quarantine. Additionally, a positive antibody test within the past three months also exempts individuals from quarantine.
- 7. We will continue to close sections/classes as conditions warrant, using established rubric.

^{*} The infectious period for COVID-19 begins 2 days prior to symptom onset (or positive COVID test if asymptomatic) and ends 10 days after symptom onset or positive test.
